We have lots of great golf scheduled over the next couple of months at some very nice courses, at some very good summer prices. It will be a lot of fun.

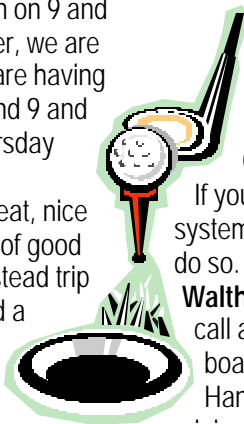
We had a nice turnout at our last meeting and have been getting lots of new members, lots of new active members. Once we get all our older members and newer members together we are going to have much larger outings.

## "Fast Play Makes For Fast Friends"

*from Pine Needles Golf Club, Pinehurst, NC*

### **Habits that promote Faster Play:**

- Drop your partner off at their ball, then drive to yours.
- Mark your scorecard at the next tee box.
- Be ready to play when it is clear and safe—you don't have to wait for your turn.
- Plan your shot and select your club as you approach your ball.
- Carry an extra ball, tee and ball marker in your pocket.
- Take fewer practice swings.
- Only spend 1-2 minutes looking for lost balls.
- Allow faster players through.
- Take 2 or 3 clubs with you from the cart to your ball.
- Use continuous putting.
- Park your cart at the back of the green for a quicker exit to the next tee.



For those of you who don't know what "continuous putting" is (as I did not), you keep putting until you hole out, rather than make a putt, wait for the next person to line up and putt, and then its your turn again. Continuous putting tends to go faster--particularly if your putts are short and the other players are not ready to putt after your stroke. Sometimes it is not practical, but if people do it when they can, it does speed groups off the green, and it's completely legal.
