There is also an ASGA outing in Chicago. If anyone is interested, email ASGAORLANDO@AOL.COM for more information.

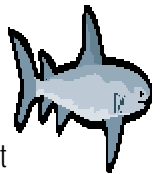
In September we are having a joint outing with Jacksonville, in Daytona.

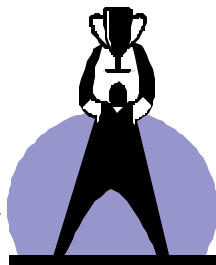

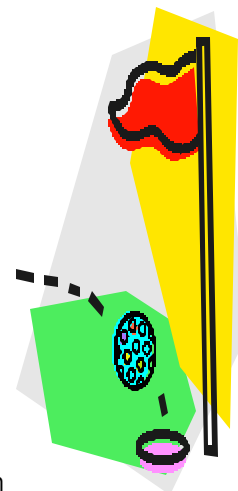

You will make your own reservation. Tell them you are with "the golfing group" so they will try to assign you a spot with the rest of us. The cost is \$48, and \$5 extra if you want to sit in the back of the boat. Don Lampton has suggested that we pay \$5 extra to get a spot on the back of the boat. On the boat ride out to the fishing grounds we will probably sit inside the cabin and play cards and maybe have a beer (you would think you would be outside but you will get splashed a lot).

The boat will cook food for us and we each get 6 beers or soda.

The boat will provide fishing gear and bait – you will pick out your own rod and reel before we leave

Don Lampton will bring some extra "special" fishing gear and we will take turns with it

If you hook a fish the deck hand will help you get it in the boat.

On the trip back in we will probably sit in the cabin and sleep.

When we get back we will pay the deck hands to clean all the fish we caught.

Then we will take the cleaned fish to Rusty's restaurant and they will cook the fish for us. Don Lampton swears he will catch enough for all of us.
