Rules and More Rules...

Q. It was one of those days. Larry missed a short putt in the stroke play club tournament. Frustrated, he taped in his ball with the grip end of his putter. Another golfer said, "Golf is a simple game, but it does have rules. You have to use the club head when playing golf. Larry, that's going to cost you." Did Larry's using the grip-end, tap-in cost him any strokes? What, if any, is the penalty?

- No penalty and the ball is holed.
- One stroke penalty and the ball must be replaced and the stroke replayed properly.
- One stroke penalty and the ball is holed.
- Two stroke penalty and the ball is holed.

AND THE ANSWER IS:

The answer is D.

There is a two stroke penalty and the ball is holed. Rule 14-1 stipulates that a ball must be struck at with the head of the club. Failure to do so results in loss of hole in match play and a two-stroke penalty in stroke-play. In stroke play, the stroke with the wrong part of the club counts, and in this scenario, since the ball was holed, the player had completed play of the hole.
