Rules and More Rules

Q. Larry's match play opponent conceded a putt and said, "Larry, that's a gimme, it's good." Larry, not being one to simply say thank you, went ahead and putted out. Of course he missed.

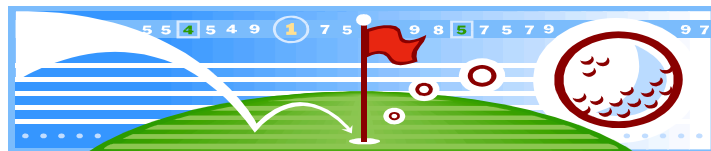
Does Larry's missed putt count?

- A. Yes, Larry's missed putt is counted. When Larry proceeded with his putt, the gimme was nullified and Larry's putt counted
- B. No, Larry's missed putt is not counted. Once the putt was conceded, the hole had ended for Larry

AND THE ANSWER IS:

The answer is B. Larry's missed putt is not counted. Once the putt was conceded, the hole had ended for Larry.

Rule 2-4 applies. The rule says that a match play player may concede his opponent's next stroke at any time, as long as his opponent's ball is not moving. At that point, the opponent is considered to have holed out.
