Our golf outings are going to be varied as far as days of the month due to various factors; with course tee time availability being the primary factor with none of the others over riding any others:

- 1) Selecting courses from the top ten courses from our golf survey (we have 4 out of ten). Others are special events; like Saddleback, Keystone and Pinery.
- 2) Based on what times the various courses had tee times available for our group
- 3) Trying to play courses around different areas of Denver
- 4) A good number of members on survey indicated they would like some outings on Sunday's
- 5) Work around monthly events that might affect our turn-out (June - Father's day, September - Course Aeration)
- 6) Staying within primary cost range that members indicated in golf survey

NINE AND DINE EVENTS

These events are something new for our Denver Chapter. They are being set-up initially on a trial basis. Adjustments will be made as needed based on learning what best works for the membership and constraints of the golf courses. The Nine and Dine events will be scheduled during week-day and week-end evenings. The number of tee times will be approximately 12 to 16 based on starting tee times and being able to complete nine holes before dark. To begin members will have the option of using a cart or walking. Registering, registration priorities, paying and refunds, etc. for the Nine and Dine events are the same as indicated in this document for our regular week-end golf outings. The dining portion of the event will be held at the golf course being played. Each participating member is responsible for all their own food and drink at the Nine and Dine events.

REGULAR DENVER CHAPTER-ASGA (DC) CLUB EVENTS

If you register and pay on time, you will be able to participate in as many events as you desire. There are limited tee times so get your entry and payment in early. All known golf outings scheduled will be posted on the Meet-up site, E-Mailed to members and published in Chapter Newsletter. Registration for the golf outings will begin approximately 45 days prior to the event occurring. NO registrations prior to the 45 days will be accepted. This is to minimize any confusion of which events members are registering for, if events are far out in the future or multiple events. Hopefully, this will minimize the number of members having to change their registration for events.

REGISTER FOR GOLF OUTINGS and OTHER SANCTIONED CLUB EVENTS

All Golf Outings and sanctioned events need to be registered and paid for 14 days prior to the event.

You may enter outings in any one of five ways:

1. Utilize the registration sheets and pay at the monthly Membership/Social Meeting.
2. Send in a signed registration sheet with your payment received by the club at least 14 days prior to the event. Must be received 14 days prior, so mail in time.
3. E-mail registration with an accompanying PayPal payment made, 14 days prior to event.
4. Make a prepayment on your Denver Chapter (DC) club account and register for events against your credit balance.
5. Utilize the Denver Chapter – ASGA Meet-up site to register and one of the methods indicated below to make payment.

REGISTRATION PRIORITIES FOR DENVER ASGA EVENTS

Golf Outings and other Social Events will be filled according to the following priorities.

1. Denver Chapter ASGA members in good standing
2. Denver Chapter ASGA members FIRST time guest
3. Other ASGA Chapter's members
4. Denver Chapter ASGA members family and friends
5. Guests via Meet-up or other sources
6. Others as approved by board members

The board has chosen 14 days prior to the golf event in order to get a count on the participation in the event and convey that information to the golf course to allow a possible increase or decrease in tee times 10 days prior to the event. Usually events will fall on the 3rd Saturday of the month and the registration and payment deadline is coordinated with the Membership/Social meeting that is usually scheduled on the 2nd Tuesday of the month, 11 days prior to the 3rd Saturday. This WILL NOT be the case for all events, if an event differs from the above a specific registration and payment due date will be communicated for that specific event. A number of golf outings are scheduled on dates other than the 3rd Saturday of the month, as indicated above.

DENVER CHAPTER-ASGA (DC) ACCOUNT BALANCE

Members can send or give the club Treasurer funds (cash or check) to place in their DC account.

If mailing, use address at the top of this package.

If you have an adequate balance in your DC account, you can sign up for events via e-mail prior to the deadline.

Methods of payment:

1. Check or cash
2. Make a prepayment on your DC club account and pay for event against your credit balance.
3. PayPal is linked to the clubs Meet-up site or to PayPal direct or by E-Mail – denverasga@live.com

Note: If utilizing PayPal there is a small fee associated with the payment to cover the cost of associated fees deducted from your payment.

NOTE: Registrations described in the steps above, we MUST receive them at least 14 days before the event you are entering. Also, they must include FULL PAYMENT for the event you are entering.

PLEASE VERIFY that your name, the amount you are paying and the type of payment (check, cash, DC Account or PayPal) are all included and correct BEFORE submitting to us.

WAIT LIST

At the end of the 14th day advance registration period prior to the event, those members that have NOT paid for the event will be placed on the wait list. If there are others on the wait list and HAVE paid they will be placed in any open tee times for the event. Those members registered by the 14th day prior to the event and NOT paid but DO pay by the 11th day prior to the event will be put into any remaining open tee times. If there are no open tee times, they will be placed on the wait list. After the 14th day cut-off, you may call or e-mail the Golf Outing Chairman or go to the chapter meet-up site and register to be placed on the wait list. If there are any cancellations, members will be contacted in order of entry on the wait list for entry into the event.

STAND-BY LIST

A Denver Chapter ASGA member can show up the day of the Golf Outing event and be placed on a stand-by list in case of an event “no-show”. This stand-by list is on a first come, first served basis and member must be physically present to sign-up at the event location.

WITHDRAWING FROM EVENTS

You may withdraw from an event a minimum of 14 days prior to the event to receive full credit. Since we have committed to golf courses or event venues in advance, if we have less than 14 days notice, you may forfeit your entry fee if your spot can't be filled from the wait list. E-Mail or call Golf Outing Chairman to withdraw from an event. As a member to help ensure that your entry fee is not lost you can try and find a replacement for the event based on the priority list above and notify the Golf Outing Chairman. If a replacement is found, then E-Mail or call the Treasurer to arrange for a credit toward future events.

REFUNDS IF YOUR SPOT IS FILLED

If you have paid for a spot in an event and subsequently determine that you cannot attend, then you may request a refund. If a replacement is found, presumably from the wait list, a refund will be made to your DC account. The refund can be used for a future event or returned to you by check. ***PayPal payments will only be refunded by check from the DC Treasurer.*** If a replacement cannot be found, then you will not receive a refund.

GETTING YOUR EVENT TEE TIME

Tee Times will be available no later than three days prior to the golf outing. Tee Times will be E-Mailed to members and also be available on the chapter website at <http://www.meetup.com/ASGADenver>. In the event a member doesn't have e-mail or access to the internet, call the Golf Chairman within three days prior to the golf outing.

GOLF EVENT CHECK-IN

You MUST check in AT LEAST 30 MINUTES prior to your tee time. This will give adequate time to familiarize you with the Rules of Play for the day and get to the first tee on time. If you fail to check-in on time, late arrivals will be sent out to meet their group on the course and start play on that or the next hole. If you are running late, or cannot play, contact the Pro Shop or the Golf Event Chairmen to advise us of your situation as early as possible.

RULES OF PLAY

All GOLF EVENTS will be conducted according to the USGA rules of golf. Each group may determine their own level of formality and any special activities that they wish to implement. Unless otherwise specified, the Club golf events are not a tournament and each group can adjust the conditions of play to suit their needs. Options include which tees will be used, gimmies, friendly competitions and similar activities. **HAVE FUN!**

DENVER CHAPTER – ASGA INC. LOCAL RULES

Three Putt Pot – This pot was established to fund gifts for our members playing in each golf outing. Normally we will have a closest-to-the-pin for both Women and Men at each event.

There could be other golf related events for gifts in the future. It has been established that each member playing in a chapter golf outing will contribute \$0.50 for each Three Putt in a round. The maximum number of three putts in a round for the three putt pot is nine (9) per player (\$4.50). We believe that if a member has three putt 9 out of 18 holes, enough pain has been endured so additional cost is not appropriate.

SLOW PLAY

Slow play MUST BE AVOIDED AT ALL TIMES!!

It is the obligation of every player to play without delay and to keep up with the group ahead of them.

Here are a few pointers we ask you to follow:

- Be aware that you are behind so that you can do things that will help you catch up:
- Forget the “honors system” of whose shot it is and play READY GOLF everywhere on the course.
- Don't delay on the greens. Read your putt quickly and/or while someone else is putting. Once you have started putting, please continue until you have holed out if it doesn't interfere with another player's line. If your ball is not interfering with another player's line, then consider not marking your ball.
- Pay attention to all errant shots. Limit time searching for a lost ball to two minutes maximum.
- Members new to the game of golf or less skilled, consider playing from the more forward course tees.
- If you are riding and arrive at your ball and can make your next shot without interfering with or delaying another player, please do. Remember – **Ready Golf**.

We as a club have to do our part to make our GOLF EVENT process maintain an appropriate pace. If you have a routine for practicing your game, include ways that you can make it faster. We have many great members and a great golf club and we are depending on everyone's integrity to take this to heart and make it the best golf club in the city.
